Following the recent government announcement, we are delighted to open our doors again for dining-in customers from Thursday 9th July.

Our team have worked very hard to ensure that the safety of our customers and staff is paramount.

Following the rules, we have reduced the capacity of our seating area to maintain social distancing, and therefore availability will be limited. However, we have decided to carry on with our takeaway service for those who do not wish to dine in.

Due to table allocation we will be serving groups of a maximum of 4 people or up to 6 people for groups booked in advance.

Hand sanitiser will be provided on each table for customers to use and we request that all customers use the hand sanitiser points while entering the restaurant. Our restrooms will be also available, cleaned and sanitised regularly.

To provide extra safety measures we have decided to serve our food on single-use, 100% eco-friendly, biodegradable palm leaf and bamboo plates.

In addition, we will be using disposable bamboo cutlery. These are temporary measures which we have put in place during the current crisis to minimise contamination and, in so doing, give our customers additional peace of mind. As an extra precaution, all condiments will be in single-use sachets.

We have utilised our time to evaluate our business and make changes where possible. We have been busy developing new recipes and introduction of new dishes on our menu, as well carrying out essential maintenance work.
